



# Statement on controversial weapons

**N**either MTU Aero Engines AG nor its subsidiaries or joint ventures develop, produce or distribute anti-personnel mines, nuclear, biological, and chemical weapons, cluster munitions, depleted uranium ammunition, incendiary weapons (e.g. white phosphorus), blinding laser weapons or undetectable fragmentation munitions in accordance with the relevant conventions below:

- Convention on the Prohibition of the Use, Stockpiling, Production and Transfer of Anti-Personnel Mines and on Their Destruction, also known as the Ottawa Convention (1997)
- Biological Weapons Convention, formally known as "The Convention on the Prohibition of the Development, Production and Stockpiling of Bacteriological (Biological) and Toxin Weapons and on their Destruction" (1972)
- Convention on the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (1993)
- Convention on Cluster Munitions (2010)
- Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (2021)
- Convention on Certain Conventional Weapons (1983)
