Please be advised that due to the global COVID-19 pandemic situation, we are not issuing invoices at this time. However, once the situation becomes manageable and an on-site audit can be safely conducted by the QCAA, we will notify you of the proposed audit dates for your agreement and send you the relevant oversight inspection invoice.

This Authority may restrict, suspend, withdraw or revoke the approval should the organization fail to meet or comply with applicable requirements and established procedures or refrain from facilitating the conduct of inspection by the authorized inspectors, in pursuance to Article (40) of Law 15 of 2002.
